

Position: Introductory SUP Instructor

Type: occasional, 2 hours per week or less

Are you a paddler with an outgoing personality looking for a first job to build your resume? Do you have a busy schedule, and cannot commit to a full-fledge job, but still want to make a bit of money on the side and get some experience?

The Ottawa River Canoe club is looking for an enthusiastic Instructor to coach Introductory SUP classes. The ORCC Introductory SUP classes are one-time lessons where adults new to the sport learn fundamental SUP skills. Besides teaching the basic SUP paddling skills, the curriculum includes a water safety section, the ultimate goal being to instill a lifelong interest in paddling and staying safe on water.

Classes are scheduled during evening hours, typically on Wednesdays every week or every other week starting at 6:30 until around 8:00, from June until Mid-august. Typical class sizes will not exceed 6 people per instructor.

Occasionally, Instructors are required to run private or semi-private classes in addition to the regular group classes.

Essential Qualifications: (must be able to demonstrate through references or certifications):

- Minimum 16 years old
- Enthusiasm and willingness to learn
- Outstanding communication skills especially when coaching adults
- A SUP instructor certification such PaddleCanada certified Kayaking Instructor** or ORCC course for SUP instructors
- Police record check

**candidates may obtain these certifications after applying, but must have them prior to starting the job

- Previous job experience in proximity of water (swimming, paddling, water-skiing etc).
- NLS certification
- Previous paddling experience
- Ontario Pleasure Craft Operators Card
- CPR, AED and standard First Aid
